- Talk About the New Year: Discuss the exciting aspects of going back to school, such as meeting new friends, learning new things, and the activities they'll enjoy. This helps build enthusiasm and eases any anxiety they might have.
- Visit the School Together: If possible, visit the school before the first day. Familiarizing your child with the classroom, playground, and teachers can make the first day less intimidating.
